Subject:- Regarding the enrollment process and determination of candidacy for the benefit of scholarship for admission/enrollment in the **Commercial Pilot's License With Multi Engine Rating** training academy operated at Dumka Airport through the Jharkhand Flying Institute under the Cabinet Secretariat and Vigilance Department (Civil Aviation Division), Government of Jharkhand.

The following decision has been taken regarding enrollment in the **Commercial Pilot's License With Multi Engine Rating** training academy located at Dumka Airstrip in clause-3 of Resolution No.-800, Dated-23.11.2023 of the Cabinet Secretariat and Vigilance Department (Civil Aviation Division), Government of Jharkhand:-

"Out of the 30 trainees prescribed for admission in the first batch, the training of 15 trainees shall be fully funded by the State Government through a 100% scholarship scheme. The selection of the remaining 15 trainees shall be conducted as per the prescribed procedure described in this Resolution, in accordance with the provisions for admission to commercial training courses in government institutions of the State Government."

2. It is recorded in Clause-7(i) of the said Resolution that "for admission into the training center, a consolidated merit list shall be prepared by the Civil Aviation Division by conducting a written exam, Pilot aptitude/Psychometric test, and Viva/Interview."

Regarding the reservation category-wise admission of 30 trainees and the 100% scholarship scheme for 15 trainees in Clause-7(ii) of the Resolution, the following decision is communicated:

"Out of the total 30 trainees, the training of 15 trainees based on merit, while complying with the prevailing reservation provisions, shall be fully funded through a 100% scholarship scheme by the Cabinet Secretariat and Vigilance Department (Civil Aviation Division), Government of Jharkhand."

3. In light of the said provisions, due to the absence of clear regulations regarding the admission of trainees and the selection of the specific 15 trainees who are to be granted the benefit of the 100% scholarship scheme, it is necessary to clarify the candidacy and selection process of the 15 trainees whose training is to be funded by the State Government through the 100% scholarship scheme.

4. Therefore, after due consideration, two (02) processes for admission/enrollment into the Commercial Pilot's License With Multi Engine Rating training academy, operated at Dumka Airport through the Jharkhand Flying Institute under the Cabinet Secretariat and Vigilance Department (Civil Aviation Division), Government of Jharkhand, are hereby prescribed as follows:—

A. The selection of the 15 trainees whose training is to be funded by the State Government through the 100% scholarship scheme shall be conducted by organizing an examination through the Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, Ranchi (JCECEB) under the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Jharkhand (applicable only for permanent residents of the State of Jharkhand),

AND

B. The selection of the remaining 15 trainees, whose training is to be conducted on the basis of full self-payment of fees by themselves, shall be made from among those trainees who have passed half or more than half of the papers from the curriculum prescribed for the Commercial Pilot's License by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA), Government of India.

5. Procedure for enrollment funded through the 100% Scholarship Scheme: For the selection of the 15 trainees whose training in the Commercial Pilots License With Multi Engine Rating training academy is to be funded by the State Government through the 100% scholarship scheme, the Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, Ranchi (JCECEB) under the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Jharkhand, is hereby authorized to receive/scrutinize applications for the entrance examination, conduct the examination, prepare the merit list, and make it available to the Jharkhand Flying Institute. This selection shall be executed in the following manner:—

- i.** The benefit of the 100% scholarship scheme to be provided to the 15 trainees shall be granted in accordance with the reservation policy applicable in the State of Jharkhand. This benefit shall be admissible exclusively to the permanent residents of Jharkhand.
- ii.** The benefit of the scholarship to the said 15 trainees shall be granted according to the order of high priority in the merit list, category-wise, as follows:—

- iii.** For candidates applying on the basis of the 100% scholarship scheme, the written entrance examination (Objective type questions only and No negative marking) shall comprise questions from the following subjects:—

The syllabus for the entrance examination shall be of **10+2 level**. Following the written examination, the provisionally selected candidates shall undergo a **Psychometric Test/Pilot Aptitude Test**, which will be **Qualifying** in nature. Thereafter, an **Interview of 50 marks** shall be conducted.

For the final result of the aforementioned examination, the final merit list shall be prepared by combining the marks obtained in the written examination and the interview (out of a **total of 350 marks**); provided that a minimum **50% qualifying marks** shall be mandatory for candidates belonging to the Unreserved (General) category. For candidates belonging to any reserved category other than the Unreserved category, a relaxation of **05%** in the minimum qualifying marks shall be granted.

iv. Regarding the examination for admission on the basis of the 100% Scholarship Scheme, the functions/duties of the Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board (JCECEB) shall be as follows:—

a) To conduct the entrance examination by publishing the notification for admission and preparing the question papers.

b) To prepare a shortlist after conducting the scrutiny of the applications received for admission.

c) Upon scrutiny of all applications received for admission, candidates equivalent to **25 times the number of vacancies** shall be shortlisted for the entrance examination in order of merit, based on the marks obtained in their educational qualification. For the purpose of preparing the merit list for shortlisting, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM) + English in the 10+2 examination shall be considered as the basis.

d) In light of the subject matter/syllabus/marks structure prescribed in the aforementioned Clause-5(iii), the Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board (JCECEB) shall conduct the written examination, and candidates equivalent to **five times the number of seats** shall be provisionally selected for the Psychometric Test/Pilot Aptitude Test and Interview.

e) The verification of certificates/documents of all provisionally selected candidates for the Psychometric Test/Pilot Aptitude Test and Interview shall be conducted by the Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board (JCECEB).

f) By procuring the services of subject matter experts, the Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board (JCECEB) shall conduct the Psychometric Test/Pilot Aptitude Test and Interview for the eligible candidates after due verification, based on the marks obtained in the written examination.

g) One officer each from the Civil Aviation Division and the Jharkhand Flying Institute shall be included in the committee/panel constituted for the said purpose.

h) From among the candidates possessing the requisite qualifications, the final result of the selected candidates shall be prepared (by combining the marks obtained in the written examination and interview) by the Jharkhand Combined Entrance...

...Competitive Examination Board, and the examination result shall be published by it. In this, a total of 15 candidates shall be selected category-wise, and the remaining 15 candidates shall be placed on the Waiting List.

i) Within a time limit of 01 month from the publication of the advertisement by the Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, the result shall be published, and the list of candidates found eligible for admission along with the waiting list shall be made available to the Civil Aviation Division.

v. Under the 100% Scholarship Scheme, only those candidates shall be eligible to apply whose maximum annual family income limit is Rs. 12 (twelve) Lakh per annum.

vi. The examination fee for candidates belonging to the Unreserved (General) category appearing in the entrance examination on the basis of the 100% Scholarship Scheme shall be Rs. 12,000/-. The examination fee for candidates belonging to SC/ST/BC-I/BC-II, and EWS categories shall be Nil.

6. Procedure for enrollment on the basis of full fee payment: For the selection of the remaining 15 trainees whose training is to be conducted on the basis of full payment of fees by themselves, the Jharkhand Flying Institute, Cabinet Secretariat and Vigilance Department (Civil Aviation Division), Government of Jharkhand, is hereby authorized. This selection shall be executed in the following manner:—

i. Direct admission may be taken by the Jharkhand Flying Institute on the basis of prescribed fee payment from among the trainees who have passed a minimum of 04 papers out of the curriculum prescribed for the Commercial Pilots License by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA), Government of India (Total Papers— Aviation Meteorology, Air Regulation, Aircraft and Engines, Technical Specific Paper, Technical Performance Paper, Radio Telephony).

ii. Compliance with the reservation provisions of the State Government shall also be ensured for the seats under full fee payment.

iii. The enrollment of the said 15 trainees shall be done category-wise as follows:—

iv. For admission into the seats under full fee payment, an advertisement shall be published by the Jharkhand Flying Institute. Upon conducting the scrutiny of the applications received on the basis of the DGCA Paper Result sheet, the Psychometric Test/Pilot Aptitude Test of candidates possessing a Class-II Medical Certificate shall be conducted by the Jharkhand Flying Institute. Admission of successful candidates may be taken by the Jharkhand Flying Institute.

7. Other necessary conditions for admission to Commercial Pilot's License Training with Multi Engine Type rating shall be as follows:-

i. Educational Qualification :-

- **Minimum age 17 years at the time of joining the course.**
- **10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Mathematics and English.**
- **Class-II Medical.**
- **Minimum 50% marks in English, Physics and Mathematics in 10+2 or equivalent examination in each subject individually (5% relaxation to SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidates).**
- **Minimum of 50% total aggregate marks in 10+2 or equivalent examination (5% relaxation to SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidates).**

ii. Height - Minimum 158 cms and Maximum 185 cms.

iii. Medical Certificate:- Selected candidates can join with valid Class-II Medical Certificate; however it is necessary to clear Class-I Medical Subsequently for issuance of CPL License with DGCA.

8. Reservation:- Candidates claiming the benefit of reservation shall be required to attach Caste, Income, and Residential certificates, as well as Non-Creamy Layer certificates, issued by the competent authority in the prescribed formats specified in the circulars, notifications, resolutions, etc., in force at that time by the Department of Personnel, Administrative Reforms and Rajbhasha, Jharkhand, Ranchi, at the time of filling out the application form.

9. In the event of vacancies arising in admissions under special circumstances, the Jharkhand Flying Institute, under the Cabinet Secretariat and Vigilance Department (Civil Aviation Division), Government of Jharkhand, shall be competent to fill the vacant seats in light of the prescribed provisions issued from time to time regarding the regulation of reservation in educational institutions by the Department of Personnel, Administrative Reforms and Rajbhasha, Government of Jharkhand.

10. For the purpose of financially strengthening the Society (Jharkhand Flying Institute) in the event of an increase in the number of aircraft and the availability of fully eligible trainees, the Jharkhand Flying Institute shall be the competent authority to admit trainees on a full fee payment basis against seats in excess of the 30 trainees for the Commercial Pilot's License Training. Regarding the admission process...

...to issue necessary guidelines as per requirement, the Cabinet Secretariat and Vigilance Department (Civil Aviation Division), Government of Jharkhand, shall be the competent authority.

11. Departmental Resolution No.-800, dated-23.11.2023, stands amended to this extent.

12. Approval has been received for the aforementioned proposal as Item No.-36 in the meeting of the Council of Ministers held on dated-12.03.2026, in pursuance of Departmental Memo No.-199, dated-12.03.2026.

ORDER- It is ordered that this notification be published in the Extraordinary Issue of the Jharkhand Gazette and copies thereof be forwarded to the Accountant General (A&E), Jharkhand, Ranchi / all Departments / all Heads of Departments.
